Madison County seeks full-time Caseworkers. The work involves providing social work services for individuals and/or their families, including children, to assist them with their economic, emotional, social and environmental difficulties. Work is performed under the close supervision of a Supervising Caseworker, with in-service training provided through the agency's staff development program. The responsibilities include formulating and carrying out plans to meet the individual problems of the cases assigned in consultation with the Supervising Caseworker. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- (B) Licensure and current registration as a Registered Professional Nurse in New York State and one year fulltime paid, or its part-time equivalent, nursing experience.
